In order to complete the MA Programme a learner may opt for course(s) from any module along with one compulsory course each in both the first and the second year. However, if for any reason a student is unable to/not interested in completing the MA Programme, s/he may exit with a PG Diploma in English after completing 32 credit worth of courses. Lateral Entry and Exit, 32 Credits PG Diploma then credit transfer as per University rules.
